Director's Note From David Mittel

All My Sons was Arthur Miller's first Broadway hit, winning him the Tony Award in 1947 - this preceded his more known works of *Death of a Salesman* and *The Crucible*. At its core, *All My Sons* is about right and wrong. Known as a morality playwright, Arthur Miller often examines how our own understanding of right and wrong conflicts with the ethics and values of the world outside one's backyard. In *All My Sons*, Miller addresses the themes of responsibility, family and connectedness. He poses questions about justifying immoral decisions and taking individual responsibility for events beyond the family. Although written seventy-five years ago, *All My Sons* is still contemporary and relevant today - the themes that unfold within the play are timeless and hauntingly poignant.

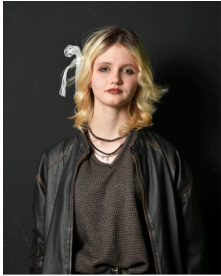

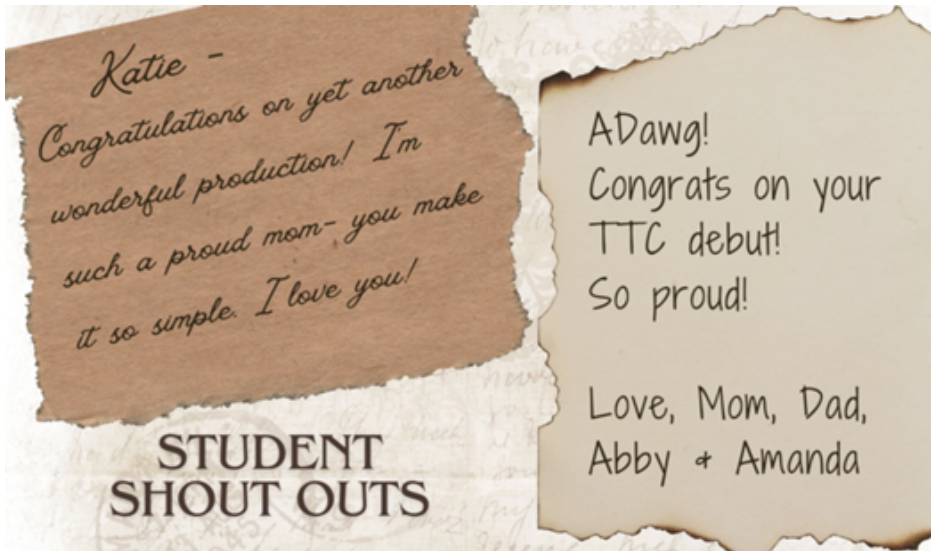
