

Technical Theatre Safety Policies

Tech Safety Dos

- ALWAYS use eye protection
- REMOVE or FASTEN any loose or dangly jewelry and clothing
- LONG HAIR must be tied back or covered up
- ONLY use a tool in the manner it was designed (wrenches are NOT hammers!)
- ALWAYS use all of a tool's safety guards and guides
- NOTIFY the shop foreman when you find a broken tool
- ALWAYS clean up your workspace before moving on to a new project
- CLEAN UP all spills immediately
- KNOW the locations of ALL First Aid, Fire, and Safety Equipment
- ALWAYS report accidents and injuries to the director immediately

Tech Safety Don'ts

- NEVER use any tool unless you have been taught how to safely operate it
- NEVER eat or drink by the sound or light board
- NEVER use headphones in the theatre or scene shop
- NEVER attempt to use a tool that is broken
- NEVER walk away from a tool that is still turned on
- DO NOT distract, startle, or talk to anyone using a power tool
- NO HORSEPLAY
- NO open toed shoes allowed in the scene shop
